About the position

Based in Rome, Italy, and under the direct supervision of the Director of Cocoa of Excellence, the Manager of the Cocoa of Excellence Programme will be responsible for overseeing the achievement of the programme's goals and planning the successful delivery of the outputs and products according to the calendar of activities.

Responsibilities

Programme Management and Strategic Leadership

- Lead the implementation of the new Cocoa of Excellence strategy, business plan, structure and organization
- Ensure daily programme management and that the organisation stays on schedule and on specifications
- Ensure oversight of all projects and coordinate their interdependencies
- Monitor, evaluate and report on progress towards the achievement of key performance indicators



 Establish clear feedback mechanisms to inform assessment and refinement of strategies, policies, and practices, and ensure they continue to reflect the desired organizational culture and business goals

Partnerships and communications

- Build and maintain strategic partnerships internally and externally, with relevant cocoa sector stakeholders, funders and investors, technical partners, and policy makers, towards achieving the objectives of Cocoa of Excellence
- Manage stakeholders' communication and ensure effective communication towards promoting the programme, its achievements and objectives as well as supporting fundraising and investments
- Develop communications strategies to raise the profile of Cocoa of Excellence in international development agendas

Human and Financial planning and oversight

- Lead and motivate a team of scientists and technical staff to ensure the delivery of outputs and outcomes contributing to the implementation of the 2022-2027 Cocoa of Excellence Strategy
- Facilitate the team to strategically plan and implement activities, including agendas for new research and outreach priorities, in an environment where teamwork is valued, and professional excellence encouraged
- Lead the development of annual work plans, including major risks and mitigating actions
- Manage and report on the financial resources of Cocoa of Excellence working with the Project Financial Analysis and Support (PLANS) Unit of the Alliance

Fundraising and investment

- Guide the development of the business model for sustainable financing of Cocoa of Excellence and identify investment opportunities
- Oversee the development of research proposals that advance Cocoa of Excellence, working closely with the team and the Alliance's Partnership & Communication Unit

Essential requirements

- PhD or Master's degree in a field relevant to the objectives of Cocoa of Excellence
- Managerial or supervisory experience
- Proven ability to inspire and develop a team of specialists, with strong commitment to promoting diversity, knowledge sharing, and staff development
- Previous work experience in the private sector or in research for development, including working with the private sector
- Proven track record of developing, planning, executing and monitoring the implementation of major projects or programmes
- Proven track record of designing and implementing strategies, polices, practices, and supporting systems in complex, geographically dispersed and multicultural organizations
- Specific knowledge of and experience with cocoa or/and coffee sectors
- Strong understanding of the issues related to agriculture or rural development, including commodity value chains
- Practical experience as project manager for large and complex initiatives



- Excellent facilitation, communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to effectively interact with people at all levels and build consensus in a multi-cultural and multi-disciplinary environment
- Demonstrated ability to build and maintain positive, cooperative and effective relationships with colleagues and external partners, including research, development, private sector and funding partners
- Drive and entrepreneurship to envision and pursue new opportunities
- In-depth understanding of how technology can be leveraged to maximize efficiency and effectiveness of programs in a geographically dispersed organization
- Excellent command of the English language both written and spoken
- Demonstrated ability to serve as an agent of change to build a unified culture and a dynamic, integrated, and agile organization
- Experience with working in/or living in developing countries
- Knowledge of French and/or Spanish languages desirable

Terms of employment

This is an internationally recruited position based in Rome, Italy. The salary is level 10, in a scale of 14 levels, with level 14 being the highest. The Alliance offers an attractive remuneration package including a competitive salary, non-contributory retirement plan, medical insurance, housing allowance and leave provisions. All benefits are denominated and paid in US Dollars. The initial contract will be for a period of two years subject to a probationary period of six months and is renewable based on performance and availability of funds.
